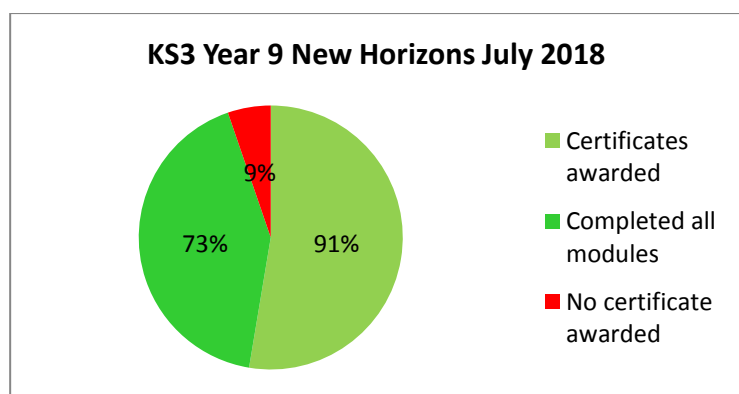




KS3 Asdan New Horizons - Internal Moderation July 2018

- New Horizons is split into 5 modules: Personal, Social, Health, Citizenship and Relationships.
- Each module is split into 5 sections which contain activities on that topic, plus an opportunity to record Personal Skills and My Challenge.
- A minimum of 5 sections need to be completed from each of the 5 modules for a full certificate to be awarded.

All Year 9 student folders and record books were moderated in July 2018, a total of 11 students. Certificates were awarded in a special assembly on the last day of term to mark students' end of Key Stage 3 (KS3) achievements.



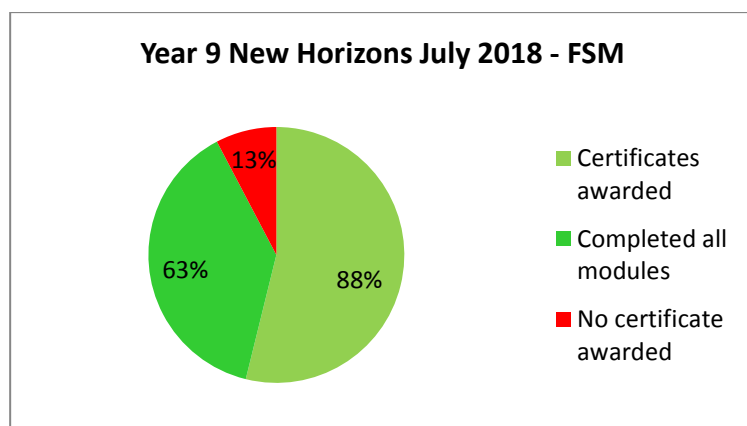

The target was for all modules to be completed over the 3 years of Key Stage 3 (KS3). 91% of students received a New Horizons certificate. 3 students each from the Autistic Spectrum Condition (ASC) and Profound & Multiple Learning Difficulties (PMLD) Departments, and 4 from Severe Learning Difficulties (SLD) Department.

Of the 91% completed, 73% have completed all 5 modules. Only 1 ASC and 1 SLD student did not complete all modules. 1 Complex Needs (CN) student from the PMLD dept who partially completed the necessary 5 modules and did not achieve a certificate.

Disadvantaged Students

No certificate awarded	1	13%

8 of the 11 Year 9 students are entitled to free school meals (FSM). Of the 88% who were awarded a certificate, 63% completed all 5 modules. 1 ASC and 1 SLD student did not complete all modules. 1 CN student partially completed. These figures are only marginally

lower than the whole-school figure. Due to the small number of students involved, this is not deemed to be significant.
