



## Tasks Development

Task Development lessons will focus on the students' abilities to complete simple actions or full tasks such as posting or sorting activities. Students will be working on their concentration and focus, as well as the ability to work with reducing support and complete increase steps within a familiar task. These lessons will offer students the opportunity to learn new skills and develop previously learn skills. They will work on familiar and similar tasks repetitively with reducing adult support over a number of lessons.
