## Unit purpose and aim

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This unit aims to provide learners working at the ‘Supported Participation’ to ‘Application’ stages of the Entry 1 Achievement Continuum with the opportunity to demonstrate they can plan and prepare a simple meal safely. Learners may need support in completing the tasks.

	<p>2.2 Follow basic safety rules to ensure that food preparation is safe</p> <p>2.3 Request support when appropriate</p>	<p>potato and cooking it in the microwave, grilling the sausages</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Using a symbolised recipe/instruction card to independently prepare a simple meal for example, using pre-pared pack of vegetables and jar of sauce for a vegetable stir-fry</li> <li>• Participating in a shared activity in a safe manner for example, asking for help when needed</li> <li>• Identifying when cooking equipment is hot for example, holding the grill pan with the handle supplied</li> <li>• Using equipment safely for example, using an oven cloth and turning a saucepan handle so that it is not protruding</li> <li>• Asking for help when moving hot equipment for example, help in removing a baking tray from the oven when the oven timer rings</li> <li>• Asking for help in using equipment for example, help in holding the tin steady whilst using a tin opener</li> <li>• Asking for help in using a meal preparation instruction card for example, what does the word/symbol knead mean?</li> </ul>

## Assessment

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Assessment of this unit must make use of the Entry 1 Achievement Continuum. Assessors will be required to record judgements on the Entry 1 OCR learner unit transcript and indicate the stage on the continuum at which the learner has achieved the learning outcomes.

This unit spans a range of achievement on the Achievement Continuum from **supported participation** to **application**. It may be assessed using any method, or combination of methods, which clearly demonstrate that the learning outcomes and assessment criteria have been met.

The examples provided above are just that: learners may demonstrate their ability to meet the criteria in many other ways. Learners are not expected to undertake all these activities in order to meet the assessment criteria.

## Evidence requirements

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Candidates must show they have planned and prepared a simple meal safely. The learner may need support in choosing the simple meal to be prepared; this will be reflected in their learner transcript.

The Record of Assessment and Evidence for this unit must be completed in full and signed by the assessor to confirm the evidence is authentic and meets the requirements of the learning outcomes and assessment criteria. The completed Record of Assessment and Evidence, together with any other appropriate form of evidence, and the Learner Unit Transcript must be submitted for moderation.
